The Mental Health Association is offering overnight shelter between the hours of 11 pm to 7 am on winter nights when the temperature is forecast to drop to 20 degrees or below. The MHA will become a 'Warming Center' for each night we are able to be open. Men, women, and families who are homeless, or otherwise unable to have shelter through the night, can come in from the cold to get warm, have something to eat, talk to someone, watch a movie and, above all, be safe. They may come for the night or may just come for a brief visit, but it is a welcoming place for those in need. Unlike homeless shelters, we have no beds, although some of our visitors are able to get much needed rest while at the Center.
